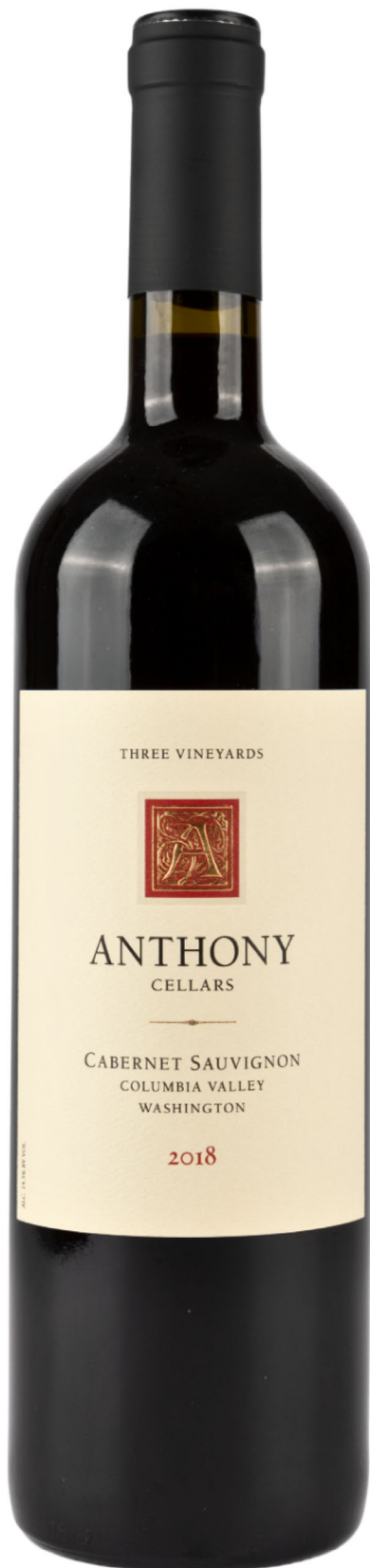




2018 Anthony Cellars, Three Vineyards Columbia Valley AVA

This wine reflects the distinct vineyard locations, with layers of aromas and flavors that give way to a bright, smooth finish. Aromas are of blackberry, cassis, plum and black tea, with flavors of anise, cassis, dark cherry, golden raisins, figs and, again, black tea.

Blend / Vineyards / AVA

50% Cabernet Sauvignon from Sugarloaf Vineyard, Rattlesnake Hills; 25% Cabernet Sauvignon from Elephant Mountain, Rattlesnake Hills; and 25% Cabernet Sauvignon Stonetree Vineyard, Wahluke Slope.

Fermentation / Aging Notes

Winemaker used a multiple-yeast cocktail, including a bordeaux yeast, then aged 2 years in 40% new French oak (1 year neutral) then 2 years in bottle before release.
